The Road Home Volunteer Opportunity

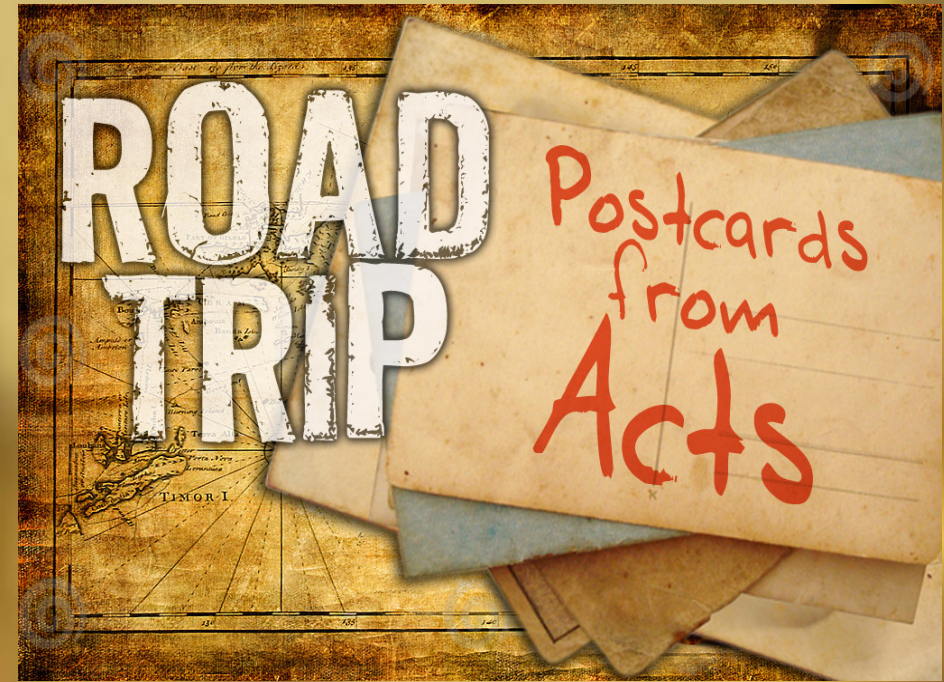
