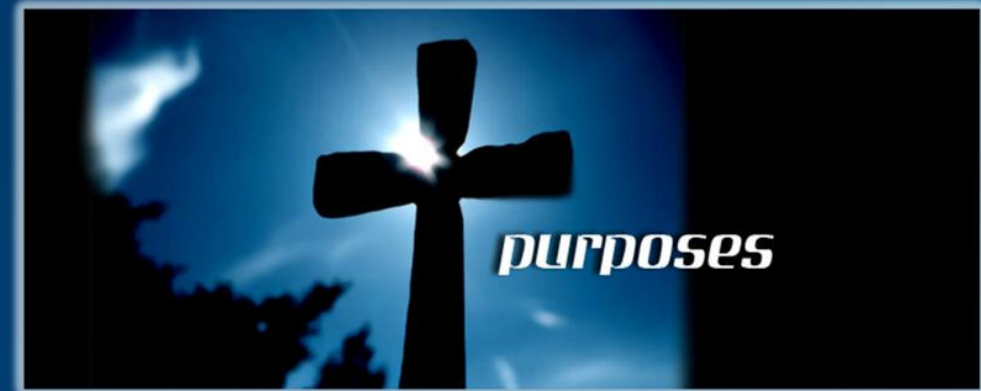

Good Friday Tenebrae Services

April 2, 5 & 7 pm

The name "Tenebrae" is the Latin word
for "darkness" or "shadows". The
purpose of the service is to recreate the
sense of betrayal, abandonment, and
agony of the events of the Passion story.
One of the most conspicuous features of
the service is the gradual extinguishing
of candles until only a single candle,
considered a symbol of our Lord,
remains. As it gets darker and darker
we can reflect on the great emotional
and physical pain that was very real for
Jesus. The story is left unfinished, as it
doesn't conclude until Easter Day. We
leave our gathering in silence and
darkness.
