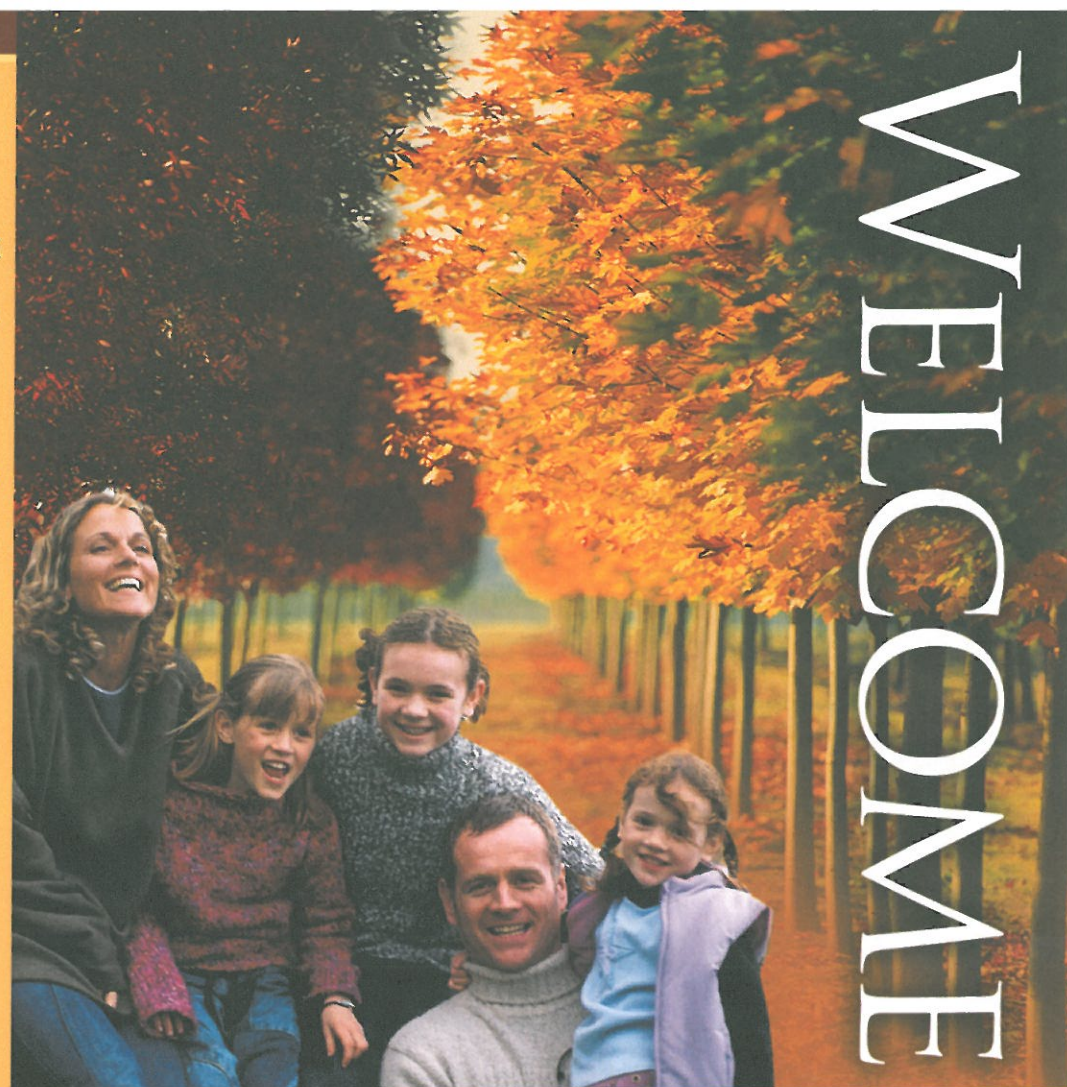
Boomerangs Resale Shop
