Annual Vote and Giving Results...

Celebration Weekend was a great weekend; we hope you were encouraged by hearing and seeing so many stories of God working and using DCC to minister to our community and around the world. THANK YOU to all who serve and give to the ministries that make this possible.

Vote Results: Annual Ministry Plan 97.3% approved, Budget of \$2,315,500, 87.5% approved, 3 Stewardship Board members, Karl Henry, Tom Lynch and Inga Werginz were approved. Proposed Bylaw revisions to change the title of Sr. Pastor to Lead Pastor and changing the term Senior Leadership Team to Strategic Leadership Team were 98% approved. **Year End Giving:** Praise God for your generous year-end giving: Giving last weekend exceeded \$130,000! We ended the year less than \$4000 under our budget goal of \$2,138,280 and we exceeded expenses! This puts DCC in a solid position to start the new ministry year.
