## A Note from Brian: One Church, Two Locations

In a nutshell that is what it will mean for Door Creek to take the first step toward being a multi-site church.

The board and staff began talking about this strategy to expand the ministry of our church about two years ago. Pastor Marc first mentioned this in the vision messages he gave shortly thereafter. Our original goal was to launch the first site this fall. Financial challenges of this past year postponed that. We now plan to launch the first site in just over a year—fall of 2010. We have a lot of praying and work to do before then. Here is how you can help.

\* Ask God to guide us as a church, to the place of His choosing, as we pursue this. If you need Bible references to guide you, look up Isaiah 49:6 and Acts 13:42-49. If you want to learn more about what multi-site ministry is all about, see: <http://www.newthing.org/>

\* Ask God to help you consider how to get involved. Does He want you to be part of the launch team, or help with prayer, worship, children's ministry, logistics, neighborhood small groups, or something else?

\* Be supportive. For some of us this is weird, or outside our comfort zone. But consider—the Lord has called us to be the church on Dominion Drive, in east Madison, in Dane County and to the uttermost parts of the world. Multi-site is one way we are choosing to accomplish that mission. The Lord's mission is our mission.

You will see more details and startup costs reflected in the new year plan and budget proposal. Look for an FAQ on multi-sites in next month's issue.

### InterVarsity's International Student Tour of Madison

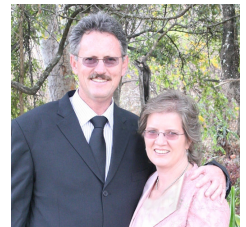

In the New Testament, we continually read that "they believed and were baptized." Belief always preceded baptism and demonstrated the person's identification with Christ and their obedience to Him.

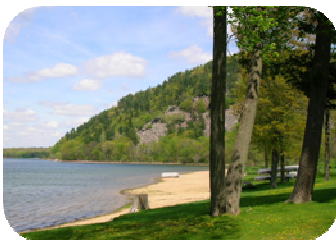
## Marriage Conference - July 31 & August 1 (Friday 6:00—8:00 pm/Saturday 9:00-4:30 pm)
